Dear Miss Gilpin,

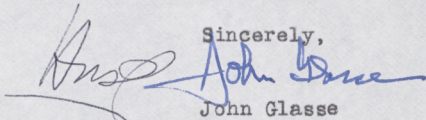
Your show was warmly received by any number of people I know here. It went on its way to its next stop the moment it closed. I know, because I dropped by the morning after for an extra look and found it already crated.
