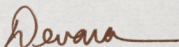
We are sending you more of our ferric oxalate solutions next week, and hopefully the weather will be cooler for shipping. Several of our customers who are experienced platinum printers have told us about the fantastic darks they get with our A & B so we wanted you to have some. (They get blacks & great whites.)

We are also testing some new heavier weight paper that seems to have a very nice, smooth surface and nice contrast. When we get our supply, we will send you some to try. It is 140 lb. 22x30".

We were at the Witkin Gallery last week to look at your photographs there. We noticed the warm, almost sepia tones of the platinum prints. A lot of Clarence White's prints are also very sepia. (The Delaware Art Museum had an exhibit of 110 of his prints, mostly platnums.)
