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

Laura Gilpin's work as a photographer belongs to a long and admirable tradition in the development of American photography. Residents of (<u>name of city or area</u>) will be able to view her work when a major retrospective of her photographs will be on exhibit at the (<u>name of museum</u>) from (<u>opening date</u>) to (<u>closing date</u>)

The retrospective, assembled by the Museum of New Mexico's Curator of Photography, Anne Noggle, and sponsored by the Western Association of Art Museums, Oakland, Ca., will consist of 150 photographs which cover her 65 year career. The exhibition includes her early platinum prints while at the Clarence White School of Photography in New York City, her Yucatan architectural images, and her extensive documentation of the southwestern Indians and the landscape of the Southwest. Ms. Gilpin has published several books throughout her career, including "The Enduring Navajo", University of Texas Press, 1968.

An active photographer from the age of 13, Laura Gilpin has lived in the Southwest for 29 years. She has documented the people and their surroundings with much clarity, sensitivity, and uncompromising directness, presenting us with imagery that captures the harmonious interrelationships between the Indian people and the country in which they live. She approaches her subject with great mutual respect and admiration, seeing no poverty of spirit but rather the richness of traditions and beliefs. As Ansel Adams has remarked, "As with all great people of this world, one is impressed with simplicity, the aura of sympathy and understanding. Add to this a determined twinkle, a gregarious intensity, and a personal glow which seems to

come from stored-up shining light on mesas, canyons, vast skies, and thunder clouds, Navajos and pinon trees - all this a part of Laura Gilpin, one of the important photographers of our time".

The exhibition will be open to the public from (<u>opening hour</u>) to (<u>closing hour</u>) (<u>days open</u>).
