Dear Laura Gilpin:

What a pleasure it was to meet you in your home in Santa Fe last week. Thank you for granting me the time to take photographs of you which will be used in a slide presentation on the evening of the Governor's Award Ceremony and Banquet.

I will look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience the flight number and arrival time of your plane in Denver on Friday, September 9, 1977. I, or a Council representative, will meet you at the airport and take you to your hotel here in Denver. The Council will make the hotel reservation for you and will take care of paying for your hotel room and your meals while you are here. You indicated to me that you could easily purchase your round trip plane ticket in Santa Fe. The Council will, of course, reimburse you for the cost of your plane ticket.

Depending on what time you arrive September 9th we will want to give you some time to yourself to check in at the hotel and if there is any time in the afternoon perhaps we can show you some sites of interest in Denver. About 4:45 p.m. that day I, or a Council representative, will pick you up at your hotel and drive you to the Governor's Mansion, where you will be a guest along with the other award winners of the Governor and his wife. At 6 p.m. you will join the winners and other guests at the Grant-Humphreys Mansion across the street from the Governor's Mansion for champagne, the banquet and the awards ceremony.

The ceremony will conclude at approximately 9 p.m. Whenever you desire someone will drive you back to your hotel room. The following day, Saturday September 10, someone from our Council will pick you up at your hotel and take you to the airport to meet your flight back to Santa Fe.

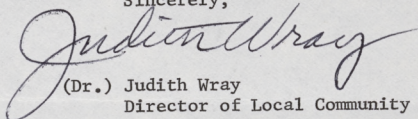
