As promised, I am enclosing some Japanese Seagull paper for you to try, and I think you will like it. I was unable to get any #1, as Freestyle didn't have any. The paper tones readily with selenium but I would recommend a more dilute bath than would be used with Brovira or Ilfabrome. It works readily in any developer and I've used it with Amidol, Dektol, Selectol-Soft, Bromophene, and Ethol LPD. I would appreciate your reaction to it.

It was a thrill for me to meet you and be able to talk to you for a few minutes and to see some of your original work. I'm looking forward to your book on Canyon de Chelly and hope that you are able to take the images you want.
