Dear Mr. Saunders;

The prints of "The Storm" which you were so long in making for me finally came last week, and I am somewhat dismayed with them. In the first place they were ordered the same size as those Mr. Welcher had made for me several times before, which is 48" by 60". This smaller size does not interest me in the least. The prints are too light; all the dramatic quality of the picture is lost and you were not able to retain anything in the area of the distant sunlit clouds. I don't know what to do with these. I can return them, provided that you will destroy them as you wish. But I cannot accept them as they are. I do not want to trust the negatives to the mail anymore, and I think I will make some 16 x 20 prints which I can do here in my own darkroom. I am extremely sorry about this, and I do not know why you did not call me to check on the size.
