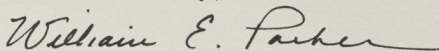

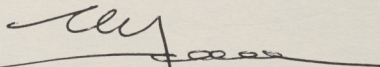
We wish to approach the realization of the issue immediately. May we count on your participation? In addition any suggestions of useful material which can be found elsewhere will be most welcome.
