I am writing to ask whether it would be possible to include a photograph of yours in a book concerning the dwelling environment of Australian Aborigines. This work is essentially an environmental psychological analysis of indigenous dwellings, with a brief comparative analysis of dwelling circumstances in other parts of the world. I have particularly devoted space to the American southwest, and have done some research in the area. The photograph which I would like to use is that appearing on pages 70 and 71 of your book, The Enduring Navajo. It is captioned "The summer hogan of Old Lady Long Salt". I shall have our editor include specifics regarding the use of photographs in Institute publications. If you are willing for this photograph to be included in the book, I would be very grateful if you could send us a reproduction quality black and white print, approximately 8" x 10". I would, of course, be very happy to cover whatever costs are involved in printing and mailing.

I had hoped to have a chance to meet you personally, through Richard Rudisill, while in Santa Fe last January, but time was simply not available. I was very impressed by your book and very sensitive photography. Perhaps the occasion will present itself again when I'm next in Santa Fe.
