This letter is further to our conversations during our recent visit to Santa Fe, in which we discussed the possibility of using some of your photos in our forthcoming exhibition "Spirit Trail" to be held in Melbourne from February to April, 1979. Since our meeting, I have been in touch with Mary Peck, & she suggested that I write to confirm our intentions.

I believe you are in possession of a list of the 6 photographs which we thought to be most pertinent to the exhibit. As we pointed out, we are a fledgling enterprise & much as we would value the inclusion of your famous work & the association of your name with our project, we are not in a position to purchase the photos outright for resale.

As previously planned, the show will incorporate a graphics display aimed at familiarizing the public with the historic & human events which encouraged the weaving of Navajo rugs as a trade item. Naturally such a display would be enriched considerably by photographs of such acclaim as yours.
