The article was never done, and before that we explained that we had quit selling to dealers at a discount. We sell so many prints out of the gallery here, that to sell to dealers not only depletes our stock, but also loses money for Miss Gilpin, as she has no trouble whatsoever in selling work here.

We told Mr. Cooper at the time that he could purchase prints for his gallery at the same price that we sell them. You still have that option, or you may return them at your conventance. (8 x 10 \$200, 11 x 14 \$300 and 16 x 20 \$350) Thankyou for your cooperation and interest in Miss Gilpin's work.
