Dear Mrs. Spiritus;

Thank you for your letter of December 13 regarding your recent order of Laura's prints. I am relieved to know that you received the first batch, as it gets a little treacherous sending things during the holidays.

I packed your prints last week, and was going to send a letter, explaining the situation, but it has been incredibly busy around here. I enclosed a letter in the prints, but will explain now to make sure this is appropriate. A second print of The Covered Wagon was not enclosed, as the other print we had was found to be damaged and it was also unsigned. With this in mind, I substituted The Navaho Medicine Man, as you originally had it on the list, and then decided against it. None of the other prints that you ordered and received were duplicated in the prints I have left to work with. I am very sorry I was unable to send the second "Wagon" print. Regarding the Luke Yazzie image, since no prints could be done after Laura's death, I sent an 11 x 14 size, which has a \$50 difference in price, from the 8 x 10. Since I could not correctly fill your order, I am forfeiting the \$50 difference in your favor. I hope this will be satisfactory. Thank you for your patience, and if this is not suitable, your money will be refunded upon return of the two prints.
