Dear Sir;

A few days ago, I had a telephone call from a new agent for your press regarding my book, "The Enduring Navaho". He said he had never seen it before and he was very anxious to show the book and try to establish it in California and Arizona, which is his territory.

It just occurred to me that it may be that on the 4th printing not all of the books have yet been bound, in which case one serious error may be corrected; that is, the reversal of the end-papers. The end-papers with the faces, which I know, were carefully marked when I sent them to you to be placed in the front, and the hands which should be the rear end-papers were reversed by mistake. If it is possible to correct this, it would be wonderful.

In the meantime, I hope all this new wave of interest will be added stimulus for the book. As I think I have not had correspondence with you personally, since you took over the director-ship of the press, I would like you to know that in June I am to receive a second H.L.D. degree, this one from Colorado College in Colorado Springs. This, of course, is very gratifying to me and I hope it will also be added stimulus to the sale of the book.
