Dear Ms. Spiritus:

Miss Laura Gilpin has asked that I respond to your most recent letter to Sina Brush. Miss Gilpin is pleased that you desire to purchase twenty of her prints. However, she asked me to reiterate that she intends to follow her policy of not offering wholesale discounts to any buyer, and requiring that all prints be completely paid for before they leave her gallery. Miss Gilpin does not recall offering you any other terms.

Miss Gilpin regrets if there has been any misunderstanding in this matter. She will be pleased to sell you the prints you desire on her usual terms, as set forth in her letter of September 17, 1979. Unfortunately, Miss Gilpin has misplaced the list of prints you gave her by telephone. She does not know if all of the prints are available at this time. As you know, Miss Gilpin is 88 years old and she is confined to a wheelchair. Because of her health problems, these matters can best be handled either by correspondence, or by telephone to either Sina Brush or Miss Gilpin's personal secretary, Mary Sue Walsh.

Should you still desire to buy prints on your trip to Santa Fe, we would appreciate knowing which prints you desire and the day you plan to pick them up, in order to facilitate filling your order. Since you may not have been to Miss Gilpin's gallery before, I would like to inform you that gallery hours are 2:00 to 5:00 P.M. on weekdays. All sales are handled either by Ms. Sina Brush or Ms. Mary Sue Walsh.
