So many unnumbered pages plus the color plates that are not counted. On a separate sheet I have listed some questions regarding this. When Frank was here recently, he said something about a picture index. I doubt if any of us have thought about this angle.

I have a letter from him today which I shall answer tomorrow about the color plates. I am looking forward to seeing all of you again so soon. Oct. 12th is not so far away. It is good news that the book goes to a second printing soon.
