LIST OF QUESTIONS REGARDING BOOK OTHER
THAN INDEX.

Would it be possible to add page numbers to picture pages, especially when there are many un-numbered together? The addition of the color plates also adds to this confusion. There are a page numbers between pages 32 to 55. There is certainly room on some of the picture pages such as 43, 53, 66, 70, 72, 81, 82, 85, 92, 93, 100, 101, 103, 108, 110, 115, 142, 185, 190, 202, 215, 219, 225, 226, 230, 231, 238, 244, .. These are all pages with no text other than captions, and I am aware that all numbered pictures are with the main body of the text. Anyone doing research using this book would have a hard time. Having just checked the index, I know what this can mean. Page 72 should have been numbered.

What about a picture index? both black & white & color.

The mixup on page 14 should read as follows: 6 2nd PP from top on right hand column

"Many smaller rites such as the puberty ceremony, the initiation ceremony, the marriage ceremony, and numerous others are conducted frequently. The great ceremonials such as the Mountainwagant the Nightway with their variations etc"

The caption on the color plate opposite page 208, is wrong. I have only just found it. This was at the Gallup Ceremonial. But I don't think it matters too much.
