Dear Miss Gilpin:

Enclosed find three copies of our standard contract form for the publication of your book. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask them. If not, sign all three copies, having them witnessed by someone who is not a relative, retain one, and return two to us.

You will note that the royalty rate is based on net proceeds from sales rather than list price; net proceeds amount to about 60 per cent of list price. This will mean that you will receive approximately 90 cents a copy on royalties for the first 3,000 sales, the rate going up thereafter; we think that yours will probably be a \$15.00 book.

I still don't know if this will be a joint publication of the Press and the Amon Carter Museum or if we will go it alone; in either event your contractual relationship will be with the Press.
