Dear Miss Gilpin:

First, let me thank you for being such a cooperative author--your letter and galley proofs arrived at the Press today, right on schedule. I have checked through the proofs, have noted your corrections, and have given the galleys to the Production Department for collation with the master set of proofs.

I am very sorry that the manner in which the captions were set led you to think that nine of the color plates would appear together at the beginning of the book. The color plates will be distributed throughout the book, as Mr. Wardlaw told you earlier. None of us knows why the typesetter put "ii-xi" on the proofs, for the book has not yet been paged.

Your original frontispiece is still the frontispiece, but since it is to be a double spread it will also appear on the title page, with the title and your name superimposed.

We will be able to make all your suggested changes, including correcting Mr. Kluckhohn's first name. In answer to your questions--"scrub oak" is indeed two words, as you had it; "bellows" can be either singular or plural, but according to Webster's second edition (our authority) it has "generally been construed as a singular."

The page proofs will not be ready by May 20, for it will take quite a while to do the paste up. I'm sorry that I can't give you a definite date for the arrival of the pages, but be assured that I will mail a set to you as soon as we receive them, so that you can start the indexing as quickly as possible.
