Thank you for sending the pictures. We will follow your instructions in negotiating this permission, asking \$25 per picture. In the future, we will set fees within the guidelines you have given me and will let you know if prints are needed.

In answer to your questions, sales have continued briskly at an average of about 200 copies a month. Through August our total sale has been well over 4,000 copies. We still have on hand, bound and unbound, more than 2,000 copies. Therefore we are not talking about a second printing yet. When the time comes, as I am confident it will, we will be glad to discuss the matters you have in mind.

We do have a London office (University of Texas Press Ltd.), which is selling the book in Europe. I think the review you mention was probably from Choice, a periodical put out by the American Library Association. It is very widely used by librarians and is usually considered the most important review medium for library sales.
