Dear Laura:

It was great to be with you in Santa Fe. A delightful trip in every way.

I talked today to Bill Hart, president of Steck-Warlick. He said that they will be glad to schedule the reprinting of the color work at your convenience. I suggest that you come the week beginning October 12; I will be out of the state the preceding week.

Mr. Hart said that he would be happy for you to talk with all the people concerned with the color work. He thinks that inking may be the principal problem but that if additional corrections are required on certain negatives and plates this will be done. They will try to make such changes quickly so that you may stay and see the finished product as it comes from the press. I shall ask Otto Ludwig of Steck-Warlick to try to locate the final proofs which were approved before they began their press-run. Perhaps this will give us an idea as to what went wrong on the press with several subjects.

Mr. Hart was most gracious and said they would do everything possible to make the job right this time.

Please send us right away any additional corrections (other than the transposed lines) which need to be made, so we can get Meriden to work on the black and white portion of the job as soon as possible.

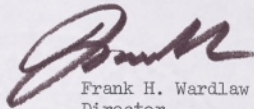
