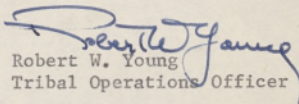
I am writing in reply to your letter of February 5. It does indeed seem like a long time since November 22 when our interview came to such an abrupt close with the news of the President's assassination.

I thought that Charlie Minton surely would have a copy of the map showing the present boundaries of the Hopi Reservation within the Executive Order Area of 1882. I called Superintendent O'Harra at Keams Canyon and he said that he would mail you a map of this type. You should receive it shortly.

In your letter you mentioned a map showing corrections in the checkerboard areas. I do not believe that there are any substantial changes in the checkerboard areas east and south of the Navajo reservation, and any existing map should be sufficiently accurate.

I shall look forward to seeing you when you are again in Gallup. If I can be helpful in securing additional information for you, please let me know.
