Your letter came some days ago and I am interested to learn of your progress with FRONTIER. Thank you very much for suggesting my name as a Trustee. I appreciate greatly your request, but I wonder if it is wise to have me in that capacity? If I am to be a member of the staff would it not be better to select someone else as an additional trustee? As a matter of policy, I believe it would be best and would suggest your asking someone else's opinion. Here at the Art Center, no one holding a salary position is permitted to be a voting member of the board, and I believe this general policy holds for many such organizations.

When things are under way any advice that I might have that would be of any use is yours for the asking and my interest is already at work.

I do hope that you succeed in raising the funds you will need, it seems a gigantic task with the ideal you have set and more power to you to put it over.

If you know of a possible job in Santa Fe or Albuquerque, I'll be down at once. Things are pretty thin here right now.
