LETTER WHICH I RECEIVED TODAY.

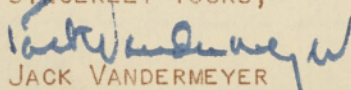
I AM DELIGHTED TO KNOW THAT YOU WILL
