Thank you so much for arranging the appointment with Mrs. Carlton. I saw her in the Springs on Thursday, and I had a very pleasant conversation with her.

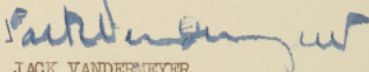
