

Every hawaii has a ceremonial name, seldom if ever known ^{except} to his family. ~~outside~~. In addition to this name, there will be one known to the hawaii people. A hawaii custom does not permit the direct addressing of a person, he is spoken of indirectly as "my sister's son, or my nephew's wife. Then there will be a nickname often descriptive, by which a hawaii child is called. When he goes to school, the teacher will give him another name, by which he is generally known. Often names are selected for among white people ~~and~~ the hawaii have known.
