

some of the weavers, but its excellent quality is used by those who realize its superiority. Some of the wool is going to a new Public Works program and it is to be hoped that in time the benefit of this long range program will be fully appreciated. At the present moment, both sheep raising and fine weaving seem to be on a decline. This may be a natural result of the sheep reduction program and, we sincerely hope, only a temporary lowering of the <sup>high</sup> standard held for so long by the management of the Guild.
