Dear Laura:



To give you an explanation of your royalty statement, the actual number of copies of the first printing includes reviewers' copies--which don't carry royalties naturally--and we still have some copies of the first edition left as we don't want to run out of stock until the second edition has been published. Often shortages occur when the first is printed. I think probably these various facts would take care of the discrepancy in our two sets of figures.
