The book seems off to a wonderful start out here and I hope it will be elsewhere too. First, I am going to need more copies shortly, so please send me another twenty, ten in cartons and ten without, just as my last order. This makes a total of 100 copies for me. Orders are still coming in in almost every mail.

I wrote to Mr. Jarvis on Sunday Oct. 14th, having just received the final word from the Dallas Museum about my show. Another letter to-day sets the opening day at December 4th and it will run through to January 15th. I am to go over for the gallery talk Dec. 7th. but will go to help with the finishing touches on the hanging and be there for the opening. Mr. Jerry Bywaters, director of the Dallas Museum of Fine Arts writes that he wants books at the Museum for sale during and after the exhibition. I am writing to see if he wishes to order direct from you, through one of the Dallas bookstores or through me. I will keep you advised. I enclose a clipping from the Santa Fe New Mexican as of yesterday. I was astonished to find it on the editorial page. A few first words or coming from books sent east, but I shall be glad to hear from you as to how the start seems to you.
