Dear Miss Allen:-

I truly didnt expect to be a whole month answering your letter, but first I had a bad flu infection and then I was way behind schedule on a new book. I am in the field at this writing and as I havent the list of prints I sent you with me I cannot give you an exact price list. In general, however, the 8x10 prints are \$15. the 11x14 \$25. and the 16x20s \$50.

I had no idea that you wanted the prints so long, and I am going to have to ask you to send them back as they are promised elsewhere on September first, and I must get them packed and ready to go when I am at home early in August. I then expect to be out again for several weeks. I will be home early next week.

If you should make any sales I can send duplicate prints a little later, but two of the prints you have are already sold, the storm and the mouth of the Rio Grande, and I must deliver them by August 10th.

I hope that the prints have been of interest to your people and that consequently they have seen the book.
