Dear Mr. Dreyer:-

The first galley is returned herewith. I found a good many mistakes and I have made a few editorial changes, chiefly in the PREFACE where I must make some special mention of Dr. Morley's book. I have eliminated a sufficient amount to include the new sentence. I shall go over here each galley, however there are several points to bring up first. Regarding the use of the Lydian type face, I requested a similar format to the Pueblos in which this face, which I like very much, was used. But I should prefer some changes on the use. First the use of the lower case italic for the Preface and Introduction headings, and then the Lydian straight for all other headings which have been set in Italic caps. Then, why set the Introduction in two columns? I realize that it would mean a great deal of re-setting to change, but I was surprised to see it. The linotype operator seems to have inserted all the notes hit or mis throughout the proofs and I presume that these are measures to be placed at the bottom of the pages.
