It was very nice to receive your letter and to know that you are still going strong. I have waited some ten days hoping that my Navaho dummy would arrive and that I could acknowledge it, but as yet it has not arrived. One printer publisher who has been here three times, has wanted, still does, to do this book, is Fritz Hartmann, of West Berlin, Germany. He is a superb printer, but does not do gravure, and I think the Navaho should have this added richness.

I am working hard to finish the text as quickly as possible, so that I can get this book underway.

As to another Maya book, this is still nebulous, though I have thought of Hartmann doing this one which could be shipped direct to Yucatan, and have a U.S. distributor. However all this is very much in the future.

I have gotten out all my royalty statements from you and find that the last one I received was Aug.1,1957. I just didnt realize how long ago it was.
