Dear Miss Gilpin:

We are now beginning to get your "The Temples of Yucatan" ready for the press.

In going through the text, we found several inconsistencies primarily with the use of accents which we were able to correct. However, there were several places where we could not tell what the correct accentuation or spelling was. Will you check your copy of the text and let us know if any of the place names or Mayan words on page 3, page 11, and page 12 should be accented since it is only on these pages where we were unable to check.

In your bibliography in some instances you give the publisher and place of publication; in others this information is not given. In order to be consistent, we should give in each case not only the author and the title but the place and date of publication and the publisher. If the material is in a periodical, we should have volume number, month, and pages if possible. Some of this material we may be able to check in the Public Library here, but others are not likely to occur in their catalogue. If you have this material in your own library, or have access to it elsewhere, would you please let us have the additional information so that we can complete the bibliography. You would be surprised how many readers write in concerning bibliographies in which all the information is not given ^{an} entry.
