Dear Miss Gilpin:

I don't know anything about the Bendelier National Monument. It doesn't seem as if 40,000 visitors would be sufficient to make worthwhile a book which would cost over a \$1.00. Ernie Knee also is working on a book on Taos. I don't know whether Bandelier Monument will be included, but in any event I would certainly like to hear more about your suggested project.

We cannot give you any schedule on TEMPLES OF YUCATAN until the final sheets are in the hands of the binders. This has been their practice ever since the beginning of the war. All the other difficulties, however, have been overcome.
