Just a note to say that the dummy came back in good time, and that the corrections have been made in accordance with it and with your letter of November 24.

We could not make the illustration on page 83 larger. It was not feasible, and inasmuch as you say perhaps we should leave it as it is, we are doing so.

It will not be necessary to rework the drawing of the plaque, for the engraver says he can use it as it is.

The reproduction proofs of the text will be delivered today with the final corrections so that the engraver can continue where he left off when he submitted the blueprints.

We'll keep you informed, and we'll do everything in our power to get the book out early January. In the meantime, we send our best wishes for the Christmas season, and hope that the new year will bring health and happiness to you and lots of sales of your books.
