I will nail down JCP Education Dept and maybe you could ask Cusie to drop me a line with possible exhibition dates.

Chris & I spoke at great length in July and one important point on which we agreed was that Nell should be very careful not to sell any prints which one considers "vintage" or of which she has only one. When she puts together her

and I really think there should be a plan. I'd be glad to work on this with her also. What is the desired goal? EH.

2. Collection (lifework for a museum, etc)

I am full of questions - we must also meet and get to talk!

3. — I will be also looking closely for a gallery. Naturally Cusie is my first personal choice - but I am an old friend of Lee Witkin and also hear interesting words about other places. Ideas?

Enclosed is a workshop I perform with a writer - we've been at it for 4 years and it is more or less what I'll be doing at TGP. What is the official work of Eelco Wolf at Polaroid? I would greatly enjoy meeting him when I am there in November.

Keep me posted. Somehow we can do something, I know. Whose work are you representing and can you describe how you operate?
