children, who were most careful of its contents. Both house and furniture were made by grandfather Elder, and his careful craftsmanship is very evident in the gleaming chestnut and shining horsehair. Like them, the Elder House is unusually serious-a teaching toy, used to instruct the girls of the family in the care of household objects
