I have just received your kind letter from Holland and want to reply to it without delay. As I have already told you I deeply regretted that it was not possible for me this time to make your acquaintance. May be there will be a chance to meet some time in the future.

It was interesting for me to learn that you have been in Spain and that you have taken photographs there. I would be very glad if I had the opportunity of seeing some of your photographs on Spain. For three months I have been there myself and I took great interest in noticing the difference of nature of the various parts of the country, not only with regard to the landscape but also as to the people. There was however such an enormous heat at times - aboveall in the South - and this turned out to be a real handicap.

I am glad that your new book is being printed, and I do hope that it will become a great success. I will most readily examine whether it is possible to lance your book in Europe (I have good business connexion to colleagues in France, England and Scandinavia). Perhaps it would be possible for you to have me sent the layout so that I will get an impression on the book before it is ready. This might enable me to talk the matter over with my foreign business friends on the occasion of the Frankfurt Book Fair in October.

I hope that you still had a restful holiday in Austria and that your voyage to the States has been pleasant.
