Thank you for your letter of August 25 concerning the Nell Dorr photographs which appear in CHILDREN OF MANY LANDS.

After receiving your earlier letter, I wrote to Mr. Helmut Krüger of Hanns Reich Verlag to check on the exclusivity of the rights to these pictures. We have received an answer from his assistant, Mrs. Renate Brzenczek, stating that she had checked with Mr. Reich and that they, and therefore we, do not have the exclusive rights.

Therefore, Mrs. Wilder of Ginn and Company is free to negotiate directly with Mrs. Dorr.
