Dear Mr. Cumming:

We herewith have the pleasure to submit to you below our figures on the printing and supply - either in flat sheets or completely bound of the publication planned for 1960 and entitled THE BARE FEET.

Our figures have been prepared along the lines of your inquiry dated August 27th, 1959 and, furthermore, with the knowledge that a top class production is required. We may ask you to please consider our figures realizing that we are fully aware of the great value you attach to a first class performance.

INSIDE : with a planned total of 76 pages on trim page size of 10"x13", measured horizontally (oblong size with back running over the 10" side) to be printed in black photogravure only for,

39 pages with full page photographic reproductions ;

- 32 pages with 4/5 page photographic reproductions plus the remaining 1/5 part of the page with a grey tone ; 5 pages with a grey tone
- 76 pages totally.
- END PAPERS: besides, a supply of two times 4 pages of end papers for the front and the back of the book; out of the total of 8 pages, six pages are to be printed with full page photographic reproductions in black gravure as well.

: the 76 pages of inside, beforehand printed by gravure, will be imprinted separately with text in black letterpress on the 4 pages of frontmatter and the furthermore intended 5 and 7 pages of the inside, as described sub c. and d. of the specifications in your letter of August 27th. The text will be printed in letterpress from cuts to be produced by us from the reproduction proof of all type to be supplied from your end.

It is on purpose that we suggest the letterpress technique for imprinting the text, as it is almost certain that an imprint by offset is repelled by the gravure ink, causing an unclear and unsharp print afterwards.

OCEAN-FREIGHT

: the estimated cost of shipping the bound books in seaworthy cases to New York dock, per copy, amounts to .....approx. 15 dollarcents.

## Alternatives:

if the bound books are to be shipped in heavy corrugated board containers (24 copies to one container) the estimated ocean freight to New York dock will be .....approx. 12 dollarcents a copy.

Remark : The amounts in US-dollar have been figured at the present rate of exchange of US\$1.-- = Dutch Guilders 3.78.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE

: based on the supply of 10.000 copies: after receipt of the original photographs, the reproduc-

tion proof of text and display as well as further finished art work together with the position dummy, we reckon that we require a production period of approx. 3 months in which to complete the submission of proofs of the entire book.

The actual machining will take approx. 4-6 weeks following approval of the proofs.

Binding the books according to specification will take another 3-4 weeks, after which the finished books will be ready for shipment.

We realize that the time required for making the proofs may be considered by you as rather long. However, many years of experience in the field of black gravure printing meeting the highest standards, has taught us not to be too optimistic when stipulating a production time for this type of work. It sometimes happens that the first proofs do not turn out to full satisfaction, so that they are disapproved of in our works. Then instructions are given to re-make the proofs before same are submitted to the customer in improved performance.

We need hardly tell you that we shall be looking forward with great interest to hearing your reaction on our quotation. Should you require any additional information, please do not hesitate to ask them from us.
