Dear Mrs. Dorr:


We have been carrying in the editorial section of the News Leader, for the past two weeks, a series of reprints from the "Family of Man" show of the Museum of Modern Art. Fourth in the series was your wonderfully beautiful picture of the mother nursing her child. I am enclosing a tearsheet.

Within a day or so after the picture had appeared on our editorial page, I received two requests in this office--one from Mr. Elis Olsson, of West Point, Virginia, and another from Mrs. C. A. Briggs, of Petersburg--asking how they might obtain prints suitable for framing. I wrote them that I would like very much to have one myself, and then got in touch with Mr. Charles T. Keppel, of the Museum of Modern Art, who today has suggested that I write you directly in New York City.

I wonder if you could advise me, first, if prints of this negative are available, and secondly in what size they might be provided, and at what price. I will then relay this information directly to Mr. Olsson and Mrs. Briggs, with the thought that they may wish then to communicate with you directly.
