of ranch life in "The Outlaw."

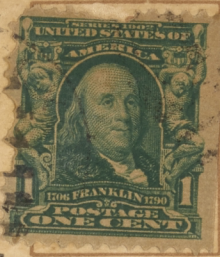
Both that and "The Marauder" are
