Dear Mr. Flieder:

Thank you for your letter of March 4.

I would like to order a unit similar to the A706 but with 75MFD as well as the higher voltage (2800 V.), internal 6 volt battery, "economizer" circuit, cable for external battery. I prefer the Halliburton case but would like to know how much I would save by using your outdoor type metal case.

Could you also quote me prices with and without the battery charger and multimeter.

I am assuming that the unit will be completely transistorized and include the new silicon type rectifiers.

My needs require a compromise between light output and flash duration, which is why I suggest the higher voltage of 2800 volts with the 75 MFD condensers. I hope this combination is possible. 100 microseconds is about the longest flash duration I could accept.

Since I want to use this equipment this spring, I would appreciate hearing from you promptly with an estimate of delivery date.
