2) One Haliburton case containingthree FT 220 lamps in housings, interconnecting cables, and battery connector cords with relay box.

As you will see the units were modified by Ascor to prevent power from one unit surging through a lamp connected to one of the other units. This arrangement is an important protection against over-loading the flash lamps.
