Thank you for your letter of February 5th stating your willingness to construct a modified "Potsie" for me.

I am enclosing my check for \$200.00 and am ordering a copy of the 2 volume Galapagos publication sent to you.

A question is raised in my mind by your statement that the photocell is an integral part of the modified "Potsie". This implies that the modified "Potsie" is extremely compact since the photocell must be placed in a position in relation to the subject rather than the camera. Therefore, I wonder whether a three-foot cable for connection to the camera is long enough. This may be sufficient for hummingbird photography, but how about for larger bird photography in which the camera to subject distance is considerably greater?
