On August 15, my last day in Iceland, I purchased five sweaters and two blankets as follows:

2 sweaters for Eliot Porter Jr., St. Louis, air mail 2 sweaters for Charles A. Porter, Winchester, Mass., air mail 1 sweater for Mrs. Eliot F. Porter, Santa Fe, N. M., air mail 2 hand woven blankets for Wrine K. Porter (my wife), Sunset Mains, air mail

All the above sweaters, and in fact all other sweaters that I purchased and had sent to America, arrived in good time and were greatly approximated.

Of the two blankets which I asked to have sent to my wife in Maine separately only one has arrived. Perhaps there has been a slip up somewhere, or perhaps one blanket was lost in the mails. If the latter occured and it was insured you should apply for adjustment to the postal service. In any case I hope you will be able to send me the second blanket to match the one that did come, which is described below.

The blanket is 78 inches long including fringe by 49 inches wide; the colm is a white and gray plaid. Even if one has to be made on special order I would like to have it done.

for the above order I paid you approximately \$150.00 which seems to me would include both blankets at about \$17-18 each.

I enclose a rough sketch of the pattern. The blanket is so beautiful that I am very anxious to obtain a second one to complete the pair.
