I should introduce myself: a photographer, teaching at the University of Arizona in Japanese language and literature, living in Tucson for ten years, some times in Japan, well acquainted with Minor White and Ansel Adams. I live here in Tucson with my wife and two children, but we would be able to find quarters, I believe, near Santa Fe for six weeks or so.

If there is a possibility for you to consider a student, I would be happy to drive up to Santa Fe during the next few weeks, bring some prints, discuss the matter, and leave final decisions on the summer for later.
