Sorry for the delay in replying to your letter of August 8, but I kept hoping everyday that I would have the latest information. However, we have been having problems with our computer and still don't have information concerning June sales. Rather than delay this any longer, here is the information through May 31.

As you can see from the above, in spite of the reduced sales price of "Baja" there is still a four to five year supply and probably a ten to fifteen year supply of "Galapagos" sets. The other titles seem to be in good shape and of course "In Wildness" appears that it will go on forever.

I have no knowledge of any tentative plans for discontinuing publication of any of your books and I am unable to tell you why you were not consulted prior to the reduction of the list price of "Baja".
