Dear Mr. Deane:

When I said I would rather have money put into better reproduction than being paid I was speaking only for myself and not for any other photographers, and I was referring only to the Iceland photographs. I stand by this statement.

But I am not sure whether the saving should go into paper stock or into better separations and press work. I rather suspect that reproduction improvement would be greater by investing in higher printer's skill than in paper. Of course if both could be improved reproductions would be still better.

I am planning to be in Washington the end of this month and will come to see you.
