We are the publishers of this English language edition and Doubledays have undertaken the distribution in the United States and Canada. Thus, your assumption that this is an American book is not correct. Our publication has been authorised by Societe Encyclopedique Universelle in a licence contract and we are paying an appropriate royalty. You will see in the imprint that extensive reference has been made to the copyright of Messrs. Larousse. The alterations which have been intoduced were necessitated by the requirements of the English language market and were authorised by the licensors. The selection of new photographs has been guided by the principle that all photographs of stuffed birds were to be eliminated. All this has been done with the authorisation of Societe Encyclopedique Universelle who, in accordance with our contract, have been entitled to grant us their licence.

Thus, we cannot see that any claim of yours can be directed against anybody else but Societe Encyclopedique Universelle.
