Dear Mr. Schor:

Thank you for your letter of October 27th concerning my Wp-1000 Flash Meter.

The difficulty I have been having with the meter is not because I forgot to flip the red switch. The high readings I get with the meter are due to some other cause. As I said in my first letter the f-stop should have been somewhere between f/32 and f/45 for the set up I use.

Birds are not at all affected by a 1000 watt second flash at 36 inches or even at much closer distances. They are often more affected by the sheer bulk of equipment surrounding them, although they adapt very well - remarkably well.
