MINUTES

Meeting held 10/22/87

The meeting was chaired by Gil Hitchcock, President.

Assistants Larry, Kelley and Conchita gave comments on the workshop with discussion on various points by Council members. Kelley and Conchita gave written comments for our files.

By unanimous vote of the Directors, Austin Lamont and Susan Streeper were elected to the Directorate.

David said we can use the darkroom at the College of Santa Fe for the 1988 Workshop -- Ulesmann.

Austin suggested Beaumont Newhall as evening speaker for the 1988 workshop. The group also decided to ask Jerry and Olivia to speak.

Final decision: After much discussion of options, it was finally decided to have only 2 main instructors, Jerry Ulesmann and Olivia Parker, to divide into 2 groups of 15 each, and to have each group work for 2 ½ days with each instructor. Work will end around 3:00 p.m. each day. On the first 4 days of the Workshop, there will be a special session offered from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. with Janet, Ike, Joan and David on finishing (matting, mounting, etc.). Assistants will also take people out for shooting adobe, Santa Fe architecture, nature, etc. After 6:00 p.m., there will be dinner on campus together. There will be lectures, social hours, etc. to promote more interaction between groups of participants.

Gil reported a profit of approximately \$2400 from the 1987 Workshop. There is no financial report as yet.


